APPLYING
FOR LEGAL AID

You must contact your regional legal aid office. The list of offices can be found in this pamphlet.

You will be asked to provide the following information to determine your eligibility for legal aid:

- **Your annual income**
E.g.: salary, employment insurance, CNESST, tips, etc.
- **The value of your assets**
E.g.: house, RRSP, etc.
- **The value of your liquidities**
E.g.: savings, investments, etc.
- **Your family situation**
Spouse, children, etc.
- **The type of legal services requested**

Once your right to legal aid has been recognized, you will be entitled to free or low-cost services.

Individuals receiving last resort financial assistance (“social aid”) and all children under the age of majority are automatically accepted, provided the services requested are covered.

If you have to pay for your services, we will let you know **in advance how much you will need to pay**. This amount ranges from \$100 to \$800.

SERVICES OFFERED BY
LEGAL AID

Legal aid is generally granted for situations involving the following:

- family matters: divorce, child custody, support payments, domestic or sexual violence, etc.
- youth protection;
- representation of young offender;
- proceedings for indictable offences;
- benefits relating to: social assistance, automobile insurance, employment insurance, workers’ compensation, crime victims compensation (IVAC), Québec Pension Plan (RRQ), etc.
- tutorship to minors, protective supervision regimes for persons of the age of majority, protection mandates.



- Legal aid may be granted in many other situations**
- a problem involving immigration law;
 - a rental problem: eviction, termination of lease, etc.
 - a matter involving consent to care;
 - if your safety, freedom or means of livelihood are at stake.

You may be entitled to legal aid in a number of other situations. Make an appointment at one of our offices.
